IV. Approval of meeting minutes December 2020

V. Approval of Treasurer's Report – December 2020

Chief Formica made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report for December 2020, second by Chief Dorn. Chief Formica questioned the deposit amount. Director Berger stated it was a timing issue. VI. Approval of the Payment of the Bills December 2020, in the amount of \$41,197.66.

Chief Dorn made a motion to approve the payment of the bills for December 2020 in the amount of \$41,197.66 second by Chief Cokefair. Roll Call vote: all ayes; no nays, motion carried. Chief Roehlk and Chief Christian were absent for this vote.

VII. Director's Report

Director Berger and Deputy Director Nichol Whitfield recertified our ENP Certification for another 4 years. The annual financial audit report for the state was completed. We have been working on the FYE22 budget.

VIII. Old Business

a. Regional Consolidation - CAD, mobile, RMS and JMS RFP process

The technical group came to a unanimous decision to move forward and present to the operations committee that Tyler was the chosen CAD, RMS and JMS. There were some hurdles that they were overcoming regarding to the fire aspects. The group will be meeting with some clients who have made specific changes. On February 5th Jim Hawkins will hold a meeting to get any new board members up to speed.

b. CenCom Starcom – Update

The Executive Board moved forward with the approval of the contract. We are preparing with Motorola and Miner. There are some steps that must be accomplished before the start of the project. Installation of a new UPS system along with the electrician coming in. We will have to work with our back ups PSAP's to allow the power interruption without disruption of service.

IX. New Business

a. CenCom Lease Renewal and Other Options

The CenCom lease is up for renewal. The Village of Round Lake Beach is looking for a CenCom to come up with a plan of different options. Chief Rivera spoke about the growth

and upcoming use of the facility. A discussion will start soon regarding the 2/4yr lease. This will be brought to the Executive Board. A Discussion ensued.

b. Budget (FYE 22 Draft)

The Budget will be handed over to the Finance Committee. Chief Rivera recommended that this budget be handed to the Finance Committee. This will be an informational item for the Chiefs. There will be more meetings with the Finance Committee regarding the Budget. Chief Dorn asked a question regarding the distribution of JETS Money on how the breakdown was figured. It was explained that the percentage is broke down by call volume.

c. Re-evaluate the Funding Formula

This has not been looked at in some time. This was originally set up based on nature codes, and call volume. Chief Rivera stated that this is something that the Finance Committee can look at. The Finance Committee has a report ready for the Executive Board. The Funding formula was revisited last in 2010.
